- mouthwash
- peanut butter
- baked goods

Signs

- weakness
- trembling
- loss of coordination
- seizures
- jaundice
- bleeding tendencies
- death

**XYLITOL INGESTION IS
AN EMERGENCY**

A really sad case, a young lab who died from xylitol toxicity after ingesting 100 sticks of gum. There is no antidote for xylitol and it causes life threatening low blood sugar and severe damage to the liver within hours of ingestion , but sometimes takes days for the full impacts of liver damage to be revealed . Xylitol is found in many things including gum, peanut butter , cough drops , candy . Keep your animals safe , and if they do ingest anything with xylitol , vomiting should be induced immediately and contact your veterinarian.
